

WINES OF CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE

Rosedale on Robson 838 Hamilton Street, Vancouver Tuesday 29th January, 2008 at 6.30pm

Located between Avignon and Orange lies the village of Châteauneuf-du-Pape. The appellation of the same name is the most prestigious AOC in the South of France.

In the 14th Century, the court of Pope Jean XXII, chose Châteauneuf as the location for their summer residences, and then decided to plant vines on the stony land which surrounded their landholdings. In 1929, it was bestowed with its own appellation, Châteauneuf-du-Pape. This appellation means that the wine production is subject to strict controls to ensure that the 55 vineyards produce an extremely fine wine.

This evening will be led by the well-known wine personality and wine agent Peter Burrow. We will be tasting the wines of the following estates:

- Domaine des Relagnes 'La Cuvée Vigneronne' 2003
- Domaine des Relagnes 'La Cuvée Vigneronne' 1999
- Domaine Bosquet des Papes 2003

- Domaine Duclaux 2000 (in magnums)
- Domaine Duclaux 1998
- Château Beauchêne 'Vignobles de la Serriere' 1999
- Le Vieux Donjon 2005, (ranking 95 point)


